

## The Price Davies Postgraduate Scholarships

*The Price Davies Scholarships (which also incorporates the Price Davies Entrance Scholarships) are provided from the income of a bequest made to the University of Wales in 1900 by the late Mr Price Davies of Leeds.*

### Postgraduate Scholarships

1. Scholarships called the Price Davies Postgraduate Scholarships shall be awarded from time to time and shall be of the same value as a University Postgraduate Studentship<sup>1</sup>.
2. The scholarship shall be tenable for one academic year from the date of the award but may be renewed for a second and third academic year<sup>2</sup>.
3. The scholarship will be awarded to the candidate who, in the opinion of the Senate of Bangor University, is the most meritorious on the grounds of his/her performance in the degree examinations.
4. One of the conditions of holding a Price Davies Scholarship under this section shall be the pursuance of a scheme of study for a postgraduate degree in Arts or in Science at Bangor University.
5. The offer of the scholarship shall be announced in the session preceding that for which it is awarded.
6. Applications should be submitted to the Registrar of Bangor University, not later than 22 June.

These regulations are formed on the basis of the original bequest. When making an award, Trustees may apply discretion and interpret the bequest for modern times.
