

## The Rosa Hovey Memorial Scholarship

This Scholarship is provided from the income of gifts made to the University of Wales in October 1934, and January 1949, by the late Miss Ethel M Hovey, of Colwyn Bay.

- 1. The Rosa Hovey Memorial Scholarship, of the approximate annual value of £1,500,¹ shall be awarded by UWRET on the recommendation of Bangor University. The recommendation shall be based on the Institution's Entrance Scholarships Examination.²
- 2. Candidates for the scholarship must be girls who are, or who have been for not less than two years, pupils at a state or independent secondary school or schools situated in any locality in the former counties of Caernarvonshire or Denbighshire. Preference shall be given to any such girls who received their secondary education, in whole or in part, in a school located in the area comprised in the present borough of Colwyn or the rural parishes adjacent thereto.
- 3. The scholarship shall be tenable at Bangor University.
- 4. The scholarship shall be tenable for a period of one year in the first instance, and may, on the recommendation of the Institution and at the discretion of UWRET, be renewed for a second and third year.<sup>3</sup>
- 5. The holder of the scholarship shall initially reside in a Hall of Residence of the Institution.
- 6. Further information with regard to the annual Entrance Scholarships Examination may be obtained from The Secretary and Registrar, Bangor University, Bangor, Gwynedd LL57 2DG.

These regulations are formed on the basis of the original bequest. When making an award, Trustees may apply discretion and interpret the bequest for modern times.
