



The Sir Samuel Evans Prize

The Prize is provided from the income of a Fund raised by public subscription to perpetuate the memory of the late Right Honourable Sir Samuel Thomas Evans PC GCB LLD (1859-1919), and transferred to the University of Wales to be administered under a deed of trust dated 2 February, 1923. The annual value of the Prize is about £2,000.¹

1. The Prize will be awarded annually, in the case of sufficient merit, to the candidate for Honours in Law who, in the opinion of the external examiner, has attained the highest standard in the University Honours examination, to be used by him/her in a manner approved by UWRET. In the case of the equality of two candidates of adequate merit, the Prize may be divided.

These regulations are formed on the basis of the original bequest. When making an award, Trustees may apply discretion and interpret the bequest for modern times.

1. The actual value of the award will be subject to available funds.
